# **PRIVACY POLICY**

This privacy policy describes the processing of personal data related to the ordering of Boreo Plc's releases.

# 3. Name of the register

Subscriber register of Boreo's releases

# 4. Purpose and basis for processing personal data

The purpose of processing personal data is to allow the person to subscribe to and receive Boreo's stock exchange and other press releases. The processing of personal data is based on the data subject's consent. The data subject may withdraw his or her consent at any time.

#### 5. Data content of the register

The register contains the e-mail address of the data subject who subscribed the releases and the time when the newsletters were subscribed or the consent to receive them has been withdrawn.

# 6. Regular sources of personal data

The personal data is obtained from the data subject himself or herself in connection with the subscription.

# 7. Disclosures and transfers of data

Data is not regularly disclosed to third parties.

Subcontractors may be used in the processing of data. The controller contractually ensures that the data is processed in accordance with legislation and this privacy policy.

Personal data may be processed outside the EU/EEA. In this case, the lawful processing of personal data is ensured, for example, by executing Standard Contractual Clauses approved by the EU Commission.

#### 8. Security

Personal data is protected from loss, destruction, misuse, unauthorized access and disclosure by appropriate data security measures. Secure processing is ensured, for example, by firewalls and other technical means, by restricting access to data and by ensuring that our employees and subcontractors process personal data in accordance with the instructions given, the right of access granted to them and applicable agreements. Persons processing personal data are bound by confidentiality obligation.

# 9. Retention and deletion of personal data

Personal data is stored for as long as the data subject subscribes to the releases. If the data subject withdraws his or her consent to receive the releases, the personal data will be deleted as soon as possible.

#### 10.Rights of the data subject and how to exercise them

The data subject has the right to access personal data stored in the register about him or her. The data subject has the right to request the rectification, erasure or completion of his or her data. In addition, the data subject may request the transfer of their data in a machinereadable format to themselves or to a third party, request the restriction of processing or withdraw their consent. Any requests should be addressed to the contact person mentioned in section 2 above.

#### 11. Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority

Data subjects have the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Ombudsman if they have any objections to the processing (the Finnish Data Protection Ombudsman: <u>www.tietosuoja.fi</u>).
